3. Surrendered to the Lordship of Christ – He is yielded to Jesus in all areas of his life
4. Spiritual Gifts – Knows his spiritual gifts and remains available to be used at any time within the body
5. Separation – Lives a life separate from the world, and to Christ
6. Single-minded worship – His private and public worship is centered completely on Jesus Christ
7. Sound view of the future – He has an eternal perspective rather than simply living for the moment
